Dear UN Global Compact Responsible of COP,

According to Paragraphs 7.1 and 7.2 of the UN Global Compact document "Policy for the 'Communication on Progress' (COP)", which grants to companies the possibility of a grace period of up to 90 days in submitting the COP for valuable reasons, we would like to submit the Eurotech COP by March 15th 2012, instead of February 9th 2012, for the following reasons:

1) Alignment of COP with Eurotech Annual Report

Eurotech is a listed company (Milan Stock Exchange). Eurotech Annual Report is issued on March 15 2012 and we would like the Eurotech COP issue to be synchronized as much as possible with the Eurotech Annual Report.

This allows next Eurotech COP and the Annual Report 2011 to be part of an integrated message representing the whole 2011 business, financial, social, and environmental activity and results represented.
