To our stakeholders:

A key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP), a document that includes a statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to its principles and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

To reduce duplication and maximize relevance, the UN Global Compact considers it good practice to integrate the COP into existing or planned sustainability reporting, and we are doing so.

We are currently preparing Accenture's FY08-FY09 Corporate Citizenship report, which will incorporate our first COP. Since that report will be available in April 2010, we will post our new COP on the UN Global Compact website by April 1, 2010. This brief extension will allow us to fully reflect our efforts – and our progress – against UN Global Compact principles.
