WORLDCOB-CSR is an international certification developed by WORLDCOB, based on the WORLDCOB-CSR:2011.2 standard that establishes the requirements that must be met by an organization to be recognized for holding a CSR policy that adheres to a culture of ethical values, is managed by a framework of CSR, and it is in a process of continuous improvement in key areas related to this standard.


WORLDCOB developed this standard consistently with its own corporate mission where it is publicly committed to promote Corporate Social Responsibility values among its members and reach of influence. This commitment inspires WORLDCOB to continually develop and offer tools for companies to adhere to such values.

An organization that is certified with WORLDCOB-CSR: 2011.2 has made public commitments, as required by the standard, which will benefit its stakeholders and community. WORLDCOB's role is to provide the framework, assist in the implementation process, and finally audit the results. 



The Ten Principles of the Global Compact are based on universal declarations and conventions applied in four areas: Human Rights, Environment, Labor and Anti-Corruption.

**HUMAN RIGHTS:**

Principle 1: Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights, within their scope of influence.

Principle 2: Businesses should make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

Principle 3: Businesses should uphold the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining.

Principle 4: Businesses should uphold the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labor.

Principle 5: Businesses should uphold the effective abolition of child labor.

Principle 6: Businesses should uphold the elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.


