Through this membership, Bouygues commits to adopting, promoting and ensuring the respect of a set of fundamental rules on human rights, labour standards, the environment and the fight against corruption.

We are continuing our efforts on sustainable development, which have been in place for several years. At Group level we are spurring on our subsidiaries and providing them with guidelines to ensure our policy in the long term.

We are working on an array of cross-cutting projects, including: eco-design in construction, the reduction of greenhouse gases through our carbon strategy that applies to both our support functions and the products we offer to our clients, the improvement of our businesses' professional standards in the field of Quality Safety Environment, and the enhanced reliability of our sustainability reporting. We are also systematically integrating corporate social responsibility in purchasing, taking account of energy criteria for IT services – Green IT, and implementing applied research and innovation in sustainable development.
