Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

On behalf of Rothschild Martin Maurel, formerly known as Rothschild & Cie Banque until January 2017, I am pleased to confirm that we support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we reaffirm our intent to implement those principles as well as our commitment to make the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our organization's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report annually according to the UN Global Compact COP policy as part of the consolidated non-financial statement in the Annual Report of Rothschild & Co.

On 01 March 2011, Rothschild & Cie Banque was de-listed from the UN Global Compact for failure to communicate progress as a result of an internal administrative error. We ask for Rothschild Martin Maurel to be re-admitted into the initiative as a Signatory via the fast-tracked re-joining process that is temporarily available to organizations.

We provide attached to this letter the 2019 Corporate Responsibility report for Rothschild & Co acting as our updated COP.
