RE: Nutritics UN Global Compact Letter of Commitment

Dear Secretary General,

We are pleased to inform you that Nutritics Limited supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption. With this correspondence, we express our commitment and intent to implement these principles. Nutritics are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles intrinsic to our strategy, culture and day to day operations. We are also committed to engaging in collaborative and forward-thinking projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nation, with a particular focus on the Sustainable Development Goals. We feel that the main principles we need to address relate to the environment, and we therefore commit to supporting a precautionary approach to environmental challenges (principle 7); undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility (principle 8); and encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies (principle 9). Nutritics will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and in the public forum.

We recognise that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that outlines the efforts of Nutritics to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy.

This will include;

1. A statement from the CEO expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our commitment to the initiative and principles
2. A description of practical actions such as disclosing relevant policies and procedures that the company has implemented or has plans to undertake in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption)
3. A measurement of outcomes (i.e. progress towards targets, performance indicators and qualitative description)
