Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Celanese Corporation supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. We express our continuing commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and everyday operations of our company, and to engaging in innovative solutions which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. In our upcoming annual Sustainability Report, Celanese Corporation will make a clear statement of the commitment to our stakeholders, our communities, and the general public. Also in our report, we will share our progress against six sustainable development goals where we are positioned to make tangible contributions including to Good Health and Well-Being, Clean Water and Sanitation, Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure, Reduced Inequalities, Responsible Consumption and Production, and Climate Action.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A signed statement by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiatives and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the Communications of Progress (CoP) online questionnaire through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.
