Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm once again that Charoen Pokphand Group Co.,Ltd. (C.P. Group) supports the ten principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we recommit our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects, which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

C.P. Group will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public. We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles and support any specialized UN Global Compact issue platform that our company may join at a later date. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore recommit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy. Due to an internal miscommunication, we were not able to submit the COP in time for previous review. We are, however, committed to providing a regular COP from now on.

This includes:

- A statement signed by myself expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions that the company has taken to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes.
