**To our stakeholders**

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing and posting our COP report due to the workload our initial public offering in July 2013 and the subsequently increased reporting and publication requirements implied. Our respective departments have been forced to allocate their limited resources towards legally binding financial reporting tasks first and therefore were not able to produce the COP before the deadline of July 30, 2014.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by October 24, 2014 at the latest.
