During 2015 and 2016, Bunge worked across its business on issues and efforts related to the UN Global Compact's ten principles. Our teams implemented commitments to source more sustainable palm oil and to reduce deforestation from our supply chains. They also worked to identify ways to apply the CEO Water Mandate more deeply into our operations. Each of these commitments and their resulting policies, processes and engagements encompass human and labor rights, and environmental responsibility.

In partnership, we are leveraging our capabilities to promote sustainable development in agricultural supply chains. With The Nature Conservancy we are developing decision support technology that will help channel agricultural expansion in South America into environmentally suitable areas and away from forests and high biodiversity lands. In India, we are helping to build a coalition to increase the transparency of the palm oil trade into that country. We continue to make gains in reducing the environmental footprint of our own operations, while applying rigorous governance across our company. We are also enhancing our transparency through additional sustainability reporting following the GRI4 methodology.
