Dear Mr. Secretary General:

As a signatory of the UN Global Compact, Bunge is pleased to submit its Communication on Progress. Additional information can be found in regular reporting and on Bunge.com.

During 2016 and 2017, Bunge made great progress in improving the sustainability of our business and the products we sell. We increased the traceability of our soy and palm supply chains, expanded our ability to monitor suppliers for deforestation and developed, in partnership with NGOs, government entities and other companies, an open-source platform (Agroideal.org) that encourages the sustainable expansion of agriculture in the Brazilian Cerrado. We also collaborated with The Nature Conservancy to launch online portals that help municipal governments in Brazil manage agricultural expansion and promote best practices among growers.

We finalized new goals to reduce the environmental footprint of our direct operations. Over the next decade we will strive to reduce emissions, water use, waste generation and energy use. For the first time, we will include logistics in our efforts, and will engage with communities to improve the state of watersheds in key locations. These efforts build on the success of our most recent program, which saw us reduce our absolute CO2 emissions by 4%.

Throughout our operations, we expanded our focus on gender, diversity and inclusion, implementing programs and engaging with employees and our communities. We contributed to famine relief efforts through the World Food Program and supported community development projects.

Our commitment to transparency remains strong. We have added Forest Supply Chain to our CDP disclosures, published GRI reports globally and in key regions and issued specific reports on deforestation and palm oil sustainability.

We look forward to continued progress, and with this communication express our ongoing commitment to the UN Global Compact and its principles.
