To our stakeholders:

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in sharing and posting our COP report due to the adjustment of our reporting cycle. Our new reporting cycle combines our annual sustainability reporting together with the publication of the COP. Since our first stand-alone sustainability report covering fiscal year 2017, containing our COP, is to be published by mid Feb. 2018 the latest we are not able to meet the deadline of January 7, 2018.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by Feb. 14, 2018 at the latest.
