To whom this may concern:

With this letter I would like to ask a change of date for submitting our annual Communication on Progress report for Rosy Blue and alliance companies, as a member of United Nations Global Compact.

This year we are in the middle of the Responsible Jewellery Council (RJC) certification process.

The Responsible Jewellery Council is an international, not-for-profit organisation established in 2005 (Rosy Blue is one of the 14 founding members) to reinforce consumer confidence in the jewellery industry by advancing responsible business practices throughout the diamond and gold jewellery supply chain.

The Council aims to build 'a community of confidence' across every step of the diamond and gold jewellery supply chain in all geographies, and among businesses large and small. It seeks to work with a wide range of stakeholders in defining and implementing responsible jewellery practices through the RJC's certification system.

The RJC began full operation of its Member Certification system in December 2009. RJC Member Certification has four important elements:


1. The Code of Practices: A set of voluntary standards which lay out the specific requirements of the system;
2. Auditor Accreditation: Independent, third party auditors who are accredited as competent to evaluate conformance against the standard;
3. Independent Verification: Verification by accredited auditors to provide objective evidence that the requirements of the Code of Practices have been fulfilled;
4. RJC Certification: A decision on certification is taken by the RJC according to the results of verification. Certification may be granted for up to three years, after which re-certification will be required.

RJC Member Certification provides evidence of responsible business practices which can be communicated to suppliers, customers and other stakeholders. Each RJC Member's Certification status can be found on the Member page [www.responsiblejewellery.com](http://www.responsiblejewellery.com).

Currently we are having audits across our operations. We believe the results of these audits are key to show the progress we have made in the areas of Human Rights, Labor, Environment and Anti-Corruption. As we want to communicate in a correct and transparent manner to all our stakeholders we would like the annual reporting date to be adjusted to December 1<sup>st</sup> 2011.
