
To whom it may concern:

We are late in creating, sharing and posting our COP report due to factors that have delayed the on-line publication and distribution of the new 2012 sustainability report (First edition of Integrated Report - in 2012 the group decided to work on the Integrated Report of the entire Atlantia Group representing the result of the work on Integrated Reporting framework in the IR pilot program launched by International Integrated Reporting Council IIRC)
