Australia Post Communication on Progress submission date

We recognise that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

Due to the fact that the 2013 Australia Post Annual Report is not due to be tabled in Parliament until Friday 18 October, and the fact that our COP report references data and information contained in our Annual Report, and includes links to the Annual Report, I would like to advise that the submission of Australia Post's COP report will be later than the requested submission date of 16 October.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to submit a COP report that describes Australia Post's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our COP report will be made available for posting on the UN Global Compact website on Monday 21 October.
