ROYAL HOUSE OF BALOI

The Royal House of Balo-I is one of the most important Royal Institutions in the South, one of the sixteen (16) Royal Houses of Mindanao and one of the four (4) major principalities called "Pat-a-Pangampong" which holds together all the communities and sub communities of the Lanao region into an ancient alliance or confederation long before the introduction of modern society and government among Maranaos.

The Royal House of Baloi is headed by its Prime Minister and Grand Master, HRH Teanku Dr. Datu Camad Ali and assisted by his daughter, HH Dr. Princess Maria Amor Torres.

The Royal House of Baloi plays a major role as Dignitary and Royalty Affairs Director of SGS.





The Philippines, officially known as the Republic of the Philippines is a sovereign island country in Southeast Asia situated in the western Pacific Ocean. At 300,000 square kilometers (115,831 sq mi), the Philippines is the 73rd-largest country in the world, consisting of an archipelago of 7,107 islands that are categorized broadly under three main geographical divisions: Luzon, Visayas_and Mindanao. Its capital city is Manila while its most populous city is Quezon City.



With a population of more than 98 million people, the Philippines is the seventh-most populated country in Asia and the 12th most populated country in the world.

IV. NEGROS ORIENTAL

Negros Island is shaped like a boot. NEGROS ORIENTAL is the smaller province, at 5,402 sq kms. It occupies the southeast, or the area towards the toe of this boot. Mountain ranges rising south to north parallel to the coastline give the island a backbone and form a natural demarcation line which, in 1890, determined the boundary between the two provinces. In most places this boundary has been almost impassable. One of the most important current projects of the Province is the Negros Transcentral Highway, spanning the interior from south to north, supplemented by an extensive network of roads which, when completed, will stitch up the highlands and the lowlands and facilitate transportation everywhere in Negros Oriental and into the neighboring Province.



Negros Oriental, also called Oriental Negros or "Eastern Negros", is a province of the Philippines located in the Central Visayas region. Negros Oriental has a tropical climate. Because of the mountain range running from the north to the south, the province has two types of climatic conditions; the wet & dry.

Held every October, the fiesta brings out the best of Oriental Negros's five cities and 20 municipalities, featuring a showdown of festivals, street dancing, a float parade, trade fairs, singing competitions, beauty pageants, among others as the province furthers its bid as one of the country's premier eco-tourism destinations.


