Since 2006, Bouygues Construction has been striving to support and promote, within its sphere of influence, the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact initiative for human rights, labour rights, environmental protection and the fight against fraud.

In 2010, we are renewing this commitment to translate these principles into practical initiatives through our sustainable development policy. This policy is made up of seven areas for progress, focusing on promoting relationships of trust with our customers, risk management, prevention in the area of our employees' health and safety, combating any form of discrimination within the company, establishing balanced relationships with our suppliers and subcontractors, respect for the environment and our involvement in the economic and social life of the regions where we operate.

Throughout the year our businesses have implemented numerous initiatives deriving from these major trends, which to a great extent correspond to the ten principles of the Global Compact. They are described in our activity and sustainable development report, which accompanies this Progress Report. In it a chapter is dedicated to nonfinancial indicators, enabling us to measure the progress of our sustainable development policy.

In addition to these documents, I wanted to emphasise positive progress made with our environmental site initiative, achieved with the roll out of environmental standards for all of our sites, together with the internal *Ecosite*<sup>®</sup> label awarded to sites that meet certain established targets (see attached presentation).
