To whom it may concern:

We recognize that a key requirement of our commitment to the UN Global Compact is our Company's annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP). We understand that our COP must include a statement of continued support for the Global Compact, a description of practical actions that our company has taken since our last COP, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

As in previous years, we are planning to publish an annual Sustainability Review this year. Our 2009/2010 Sustainability Review will include our COP as well as updates on our progress and vision across all areas of sustainability in our business. In our 2009/2010 Sustainability Review, we report on the progress of our Company as well as the Coca-Cola system, which comprises the performance of more than 300 bottling partners. Due to an upgrade in our data collection and verification for the Coca-Cola system, we are delayed in releasing our report. Currently, we plan to release our report on November 30, 2010.

We hereby ask for a 30-day extension period to submit our Company's COP to the date of December 1, 2010. Our new COP report will be released on our Company website as well as posted to the UN Global Compact's website at this time.
