Grace period for TOMRA's first Communication on Progress

Tomra Systems ASA recognizes that the preparation of a Communication on Progress (COP) on an annual basis is an important element of participation in the UN Global Compact.

It is also noted that the COP should include 3 elements – one of which is a measurement of outcomes. In addition, TOMRA values the availability of relevant information on a timely basis.

As the annual report for Tomra Systems ASA covers the calendar year, submitting a COP in December would mean using environmental and other information that was almost one year old. As a result, we would like to delay the submission of our first COP to enable us to combine it with our annual reporting, which also includes a section on corporate responsibility.

The 2010 annual report for Tomra Systems ASA will be published on 6th April 2011. Therefore we respectfully request an extension to the COP deadline and a new submission date of 6th April 2011.
