Dear Mr. Secretary General

I am pleased to confirm that Chaudhary Group supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.

With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day to day operation of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advances the broader development goals of the United Nation, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Chaudhary Group will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public. I am also pleased to inform you that we have already signed MoU with UNDP Nepal with our commitment to support SDG through our business group and our foundation related humanitarian works.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global compact and annually thereafter according to the Global compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e. disclosure of any relevant policies, implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issues areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption.)
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e. the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurement of results.

Also, we would like to clarify and accept that COP was not submitted on behalf of CG because the previous person who was submitting COP has left the job but somehow missed to handover this responsibility to the incoming personnel. The management was upon impression that we have been submitting this every year as per our commitment. We are extremely sorry for not been able to submit this since 2012. However it has come to our attention recently. We take complete responsibility of this issue and we will make sure to update the COP every year. We already have a responsible staff with this particular duty at our organization. Thanking you again for your understanding.
