Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am writing to express WET Consultant Engineers' renewed commitment to the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact in the areas of human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to keep implementing those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. WET Consultant Engineers will make a clear statement of this renewed commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress annually according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. We were unable to meet the original 2018 deadline for the COP due to an error in communication (a mistyped email address prevented us from receiving any communications from the UN Global Compact, and from accessing the company's account on the UN Global Compact website), and we do sincerely apologize for that. We remain committed to report on progress regularly and look forward to sharing with you our COP as soon as possible.

- A statement signed by myself expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles.
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e. the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
