Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that BIGMOND supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. BIGMOND will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).



We are concern that in 2014 this company registered as Security Jobs S.A.C, in 2015 the Communication on Progress (COP) document was delivered and in 2016, the area responsible of these issues was without a person in charge and for that reason the corresponding evidences were not sent. We apologized and expressed our commitment to give the follow-up that deserves a topic of vital importance, since we are very interested in continuing updating our processes to follow the 10 principles of the Global Compact and we already started working on it.

It should be noted that our work team is aligned and informed about these topics and motivates us to be committed with the agreed strategies of CSR and the principles of the Global Compact.
