I am pleased to reconfirm that COMSA Corporación de Infraestructuras S.L. supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. COMSA Corporación de Infraestructuras S.L. will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The reason why we did not submit a Communication on Progress in the last years as a Group is because we were involved in an internal restructuration of the company, after which we are now able to carry out a centralized and transversal management of Global Compact principles. Although during this period, some of our subsidiaries who were listed in Global Compact, have been submitting their Communication on Progress regularly.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *one year* of joining the Global Compact, and *annually* thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy.
