I am pleased to reconfirm that ASOCIACION GINSO supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. ASOCIACION GINSO will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The reason why we did not submit a Communication on Progress in the last year is that we have renewed the Directorate of the Corporate Social Responsibility Area during the month of November-19. Mrs Blanca Sanz, the new Director of the CSR Area, has sent the corresponding progress report during de first fortnight of January 2020. We regret the delay in presenting our progress during the 2019 period.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *two years* of joining the Global Compact, and *every two years* thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
