Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I would hereby request that my company Green Touches, which has been de-listed, be listed again as a company that wholly supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. There was a mistake made on the billing and we were not obliged to pay but we were still invoiced. As a result of non-payment of these invoices we were de-listed. When Green Touches joined in October 2017, we joined as a *Signatory* and the local network UAE, at this time did not take any payments from SMEs. As the CEO of Green Touches, we are and still continue to be fully committed to having the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Green Touches will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We are aware (and have as members already completed our COP), that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
