I am pleased to reconfirm that *FUNDACION PARA EL FOMENTO DEL DESARROLLO Y LA INTEGRACIÓN (FUNDACIÓN FDI) –former FUNDACIÓN DEPORTE INTEGRA-* supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our organization, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. *FUNDACIÓN FDI* will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The reason why we did not submit a Communication on Engagement in the last two years is that our company was in a structural change (including naming) and our priorities was to build strong bases of the company. Now we are ready to restart our commitment stronger than before.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *two years* of joining the Global Compact, and *every two years* thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
