Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm **ANHAM FZCO** re-commitment to support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are re-committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture, and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **ANHAM** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles.

We freely admit that we were lax in our efforts to provide the annual COP as required, in part this was due to changes in personnel, and in mission parameters that come with operations within the War-zone of Afghanistan, where our humanitarian and community efforts in relation to our current contract have been focused since 2013. We have created a newly dedicated ANHAM Sustainability Department headed by our POC, Alberto Valdez, Director of Quality Assurance, who is directly responsible for the annual COP and Sustainability report to be completed and submitted as required. Please accept our current Sustainability Report as our COP for re-instatement to the UNGC. We would like to re-commit to the UNGC at the Participant Level.

We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore re-commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
