Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to reconfirm that *Fundación Nortempo* supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our organization, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. *Fundación Nortempo* will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The reason why we did not submit a Communication on Engagement in the last two years is that there was a change in foundation management, which we have resumed today.

We are currently working with projects that promote the employability, training and development of human capital and the integration of people into the labour market and their social inclusion, working equal opportunities, the protection of human rights and eliminating discrimination.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *two years* of joining the Global Compact, and *every two years* thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
