Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that at Tohum Autism Foundation, we are determined in our re-commitment to UN Global Compact and Global Compact's ten principles with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this re-commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

On May 2, 2019 Tohum Autism Foundation was de-listed as a Global Member due to the failure to communicate progress. During this period, Tohum Autism Foundation went through major organizational re-structuring. With our renewed configuration of duties, UN Global Compact will be the priority of a designated officer, whom will be in charge of our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following ways:

- Support UN Global Compact business participants as they implement and report on their sustainability efforts.
- Engage with Global Compact Local Networks.
- Join and/or support issue platforms and workstreams.



We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support and engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
