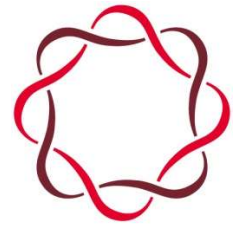

Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that Finance Denmark supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact by contributing to the work in Global Compact Network Denmark e.g. on Science Based Targets, Future Fit and working group on sustainable finance. Our work on a Framework for Financed Emissions Accounting and our members setting targets for reductions of emissions are also contributing to Global Compact strategy for more ambitious climate targets.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
