I am pleased to confirm that WeDO5, Association to support Female Led Impact Startups, supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

WeDO5 – "5" stands for SDG 5 – we are supporting females to live an independent life and earn minimum decent income for themselves by GoodStartup School, an incubator for female impact startups delivered in also in special editions like: for young entrepreneurs in under resourced communities; for older females being layed-off during Covid or in general. The GoodStartup as program is requiring that at least one SDG is supported by the products and solutions developed by participants.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact.
