Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Nortura SA supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles.

We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

Nortura will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

Nortura SA is one of Norway's largest food producers, focusing primarily on the production of meat and eggs. As a co-operative, we are owned by more than 17.000 Norwegian small-scale and family-owned farmers across the entire country. We have high ambitions for our sustainability work; by 2030, our goal is to become Norway's most sustainable food producer. We believe this will not only have a substantial impact on the transformation of the Norwegian food system in a more sustainable direction; our hope is also that we can lead the way internationally and inspire other companies and nations by showing that sustainable agriculture and food production is in fact possible.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy.

This includes:

1. A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
2. A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
