Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Cytiva Sweden supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. As a subsidiary to Cytiva, already a part of UNGC, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engage in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Cytiva Sweden will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public through our parent company Cytiva and the annual Cytiva Sustainability report and through the national local network in Sweden.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report through our mother company Cytiva, on progress within *one year* of joining the UN Global Compact, and *annually* thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles.
- A description of practical actions that Cytiva Sweden has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles and a measurement of outcomes
