Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Arts Council Korea supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

- Implement the ten principles through our own strategies and operations.
- Engage with the UN Global Compact working groups and local networks by proposing and participating in initiatives and actions.
- Communicate and report on our progress and efforts in the sustainability continuously.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *two years* of joining the Global Compact and *every two years* thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.

Our company was delisted on July 2021 as we could not submit our COE due to personnel changes and internal miscommunication. We send this letter of recommitment with our COE on our efforts to implement the ten principles and we will hereupon commit to fulfill the responsibilities articulated in the UNGC policies.
