Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Premet New York Import & Export Corp. supports the "Ten Principles of the United Nacional Global Compact" on human rights, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and it's principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the "Sustainable Development Goals".
