We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

- Share best practice and facilitate partnerships to support businesses to promote and respect children's rights in all their operations, with a particular focus on supply chains
- Support / participate in UNGC Annual Business Associations Forum on Sustainable Development where possible to scale action child rights and business
- Support UN Global Compact business participants as they implement and report on their sustainability efforts, with a particular focus on helping businesses to understand where and how their supply chain-related operations impact children, and offering practical solutions and recommendations to manage risks
- Engage with Global Compact Local Networks in countries where we are active on our programmes to address child labour, increase support and protections for migrant parent workers, young workers, strengthen protections for women and establish family friendly workplaces in supply chains
- Join and/or support issue platforms and workstreams where appropriate, including UNGC workstream related to supply chains and decent work

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact.
