We recognize a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) describing our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We are ready to fulfil this commitment.

ESG is a core value and brand pillar at Fisker. We take our responsibilities to ethical and fair treatment of people, communities, and the environment very seriously. As a leader in e-mobility solutions and electric vehicles, we are committed to integrating our strict social and environmental standards and responsible governance model into all our business practices. We do so responsibly and with transparency by publishing our governance, environmental, and social policies and measurement of targets and outcomes on an annual basis.

Our approach to ESG consists of industry leadership, transparency, partnerships, and real-world scientific measurement. We publicly disclose our governance policies and our strict supply chain standards, as seen in our Responsible Supplier Policy. This policy includes ILO labour standards and responsible chain of custody for materials, including that of conflict minerals. This policy applies to our internal workforce, contracted manufacturing, and all suppliers contributing to our products and services globally. As we develop our products, we also develop partnerships aligning with UNSDGs.
