Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to reconfirm that *Academia de Formación García Ibáñez S.L.* supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our organization, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. *Academia de Formación García Ibáñez S.L.* will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The reason why we did not submit a Communication on Engagement in the last two years is that the changes suffered on an international level due to Covid-19, obliged us to reorganise our business structure at a determined level and to concentrate on problems appearing at staff level. The urgency to adapt to these changes caused the exclusion of other kinds of functions considered to be less urgent, taking into account the survival of the enterprise and thus the continuation of the tasks considered necessary to maintain the firm within the world pact.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the biannual submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within *two years* of joining the Global Compact, and *every two years* thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
