Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Ingevity supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations (UN) Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. We will continue our work to embed the environmental, social and governance principles of the UN Global Compact into our strategy and operations and will engage in projects that advance the UN's broader development goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles, and commit to reporting on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles – which is separate from our initial letter of commitment – to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions that Ingevity has taken, or plans to undertake, to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas – human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.
- A measurement of outcomes, such as the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results.

We believe deeply in safeguarding the health of our planet for future generations by creating sustainable solutions that purify, protect and enhance the lives of our employees, customers and communities, and will work alongside our partners in the UN Global Compact to advance important social and environmental goals to improve our world.
