We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

EDUCADEMY continues to support UN Sustainable Developmental Goals, specifically Goal 4 to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all and Goal 5 to achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website as soon as the UN Global Compact technology team is able to identify submission issue and give access to upload pdf document which includes:

- •A statement signed by the chief executive officer expressing continuous support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- •A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four targeted areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption).
- •A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the target based results/ KPIs or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
