PerkinElmer has made progress in several of the SDGs and can confidently make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders, customers, employees and the general public.


We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, as demonstrated through our Corporate Social Responsibility reports and commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).

PerkinElmer, Inc. initially became a signatory company of the UN Global Compact in 2008. After making this pledge and demonstrating our commitment through executing on environmental, social and governance initiatives and filing our Communication on Progress for several years, the Company went through substantial organizational restructuring which impacted the ability to maintain the annual Communication on Progress. While we were not a formal member of the Compact during this period, we did operate our company in accordance with the standards set forth herein. PerkinElmer remains committed to supporting the UN Global Compact Ten Principles and

respectfully requests to be reinstated as an active member. The Company is actively engaged globally and is continues to operate within the Principles and the Sustainable Development Goals with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.
