Dear Mr. Secretary-General

I am pleased to confirm that Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles.

This commitment aligns with our increasing focus on Environment, Social and Governance (ESG) within our company and our ESG ambition of modal shift to rail for a sustainable future supported by priority actions and targets.

Australia is a signatory to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals which provides a blueprint for global action and ARTC is committed to taking action to support this, including engaging in partnerships.

We recognise that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact
- A description of practical actions that the company is taking in relation to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption
- A measurement of outcomes and degree to which qualitative and quantitative targets or performance indicators were met
