Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that NTT Ltd supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. NTT Ltd will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We published our [Sustainability Ambition](#) in November 2021. It sets out how we are working toward a more sustainable world through our people, our operations and our technology solutions. It is guided by the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals and focuses on three interconnected themes of planet, communities and economy and to which we are dedicating our resources. We have made clear commitments in each area, including net zero emissions across our operations by 2030 and net zero across our value chain by 2040.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the Chief Executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten



Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

At NTT Ltd, our commitment to the UN Global Compact and sustainable development is central to our purpose of enabling the connected future. We see an interconnected world where technology has the power to bring things and people together—and change our collective future for the better.
