We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact by developing tools, promoting best practices and strengthen key sustainability priorities such as anti-corruption and by implementing and reporting on our sustainability efforts.

The Danish Brewers' Association is aware that the brewing sector carries a great responsibility and therefore we wish to do our very best to accelerate our work with sustainability with respect for public health, environmental sustainability and with care for the employees.

The Danish breweries and bottling companies have these ambitions for 2030:

- No irresponsible consumption of the industry's products.
- All production must be 100% CO₂-neutral.
- All packaging must be circular.
- The consumption of water, raw materials and materials must be reduced.
- No employees are affected by occupational accidents.

With the membership of UN's Global Compact, the Danish Brewers' Association will work strategically and targeted with sustainability as a value-creating element in the association and strive to become even better at responsible business management in terms of complying with the Global Compacts 10 principles and fulfilling the UN's global goals.
