I am pleased to confirm that the Solten group supports the ten principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of the Solten group, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.  will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business
 strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the
 Sustainable Development Goals.
