- Engage with Global Compact Local Networks, starting here in the Netherlands, where we currently organize the <u>Living Wage & Income Lab</u>.
- Promote UN Global Compact tools such as the Decent Work Toolkit for Sustainable Procurement, the Guide to Traceability and the Practical Guide for Continuous Improvement to assist companies in developing more sustainable supply chain practices.
