Over the last years, DCAF has actively provided its expertise on issues of business, security, and human rights on numerous occasions to Global Compact national networks for example those in Switzerland and Liechtenstein, Germany, and Japan. DCAF has supported the team working on the <u>Business and Human Rights Navigator</u> (a UNGC product) with regards to business and security as well as conflict sensitivity issues. UN Global Compact tools and guidance are widely referenced in our flagship Security and Human Rights Toolkit and are available on Security and Human Rights Knowledge Hub for easy access by companies looking for guidance on business and human rights.

Building on this work, we pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):
