Samsung will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. - A description of practical actions that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas of human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption.
