Dear Secretary-General,

General Electric Company has maintained a longstanding commitment to the UN Global Compact since 2008. As GE Vernova prepares to spinoff from GE to be a separate standalone company in the second quarter of 2024, we are pleased to confirm our continued commitment to the UN Global Compact at GE Vernova. We support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

GE Vernova will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public. We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by myself and the Chief Sustainability Officer expressing our continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to the United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.
- Report of GE Vernova's key performance indicators and metrics on our sustainability performance.
