Letter of Re-Commitment

I wish to confirm MTN Nigeria Communications PLC commitment to re-join the United Nations Global Compact, which it was previously a participant but was delisted for failing to submit a Communication on Progress (CoP). Regrettably, our annual submission of CoP lapsed in 2019 due in part to an internal misalignment between us and our parent company, the MTN Group. In renewing our membership of the UNGC as a subsidiary of the MTN Group, and as a member of the UNGC Nigeria network.

I am therefore pleased to confirm that MTN Nigeria Communications PLC supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture, and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. MTN Nigeria Communications PLC will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles.
